

MINISTRY EXPECTATIONS

How do I become a member of A & E?

An interest can be indicated on the Stewardship of Talent card; or you may speak with or contact any member.

What defines an "active" member of A & E?

Regular participation and response to email and phone calls. Core Group members should attend meetings, Baptismal Bib sewers should complete new bibs on schedule and Plant Watering specialists should water the large plants once a month.

How do I end my membership in A & E?

Notify a committee member directly or by phone or email.

Is the attire of the member important?

Clothing should be comfortable and appropriate for the work being done.

What special talents/characteristics are desired in a member of A & E?

Flexibility, a willingness to share ideas and learn new skills. Bib sewers need to have basic sewing skills.

What is the time commitment?

The Core Team meets once a month. Members participate in activities; most notably during the Advent/Christmas and Lent/Easter seasons. Seasonal helpers are involved for the main holidays. Sewers sew 8-10 hours a year and waterers water about 1 hour a month.

What can I expect in the way of support/training for my role in A & E?

There will always be someone to train bib sewers and plant watering specialists; we learn together as we change and grow!
