MINISTRY EXPECTATIONS

How do I become a member of the Respect Life Committee? An interest in the committee can be indicated on the Stewardship of Talent card; or you may contact the parish office or the ministry leader, directly.

What defines an "active" member of the ministry? Participation in at least one respect life activity during the year. And someone who wants to receive emails about life issues and legislation.

How do I end my membership in the ministry?

Notify the committee leader or the parish office that you are no longer interested in being a member.

Is the attire of the member important? No.


What special talents/characteristics are desired in a member of the ministry? Compassion and a knowledge and awareness of organizations that provide pregnancy assistance.


Parish Mission

What We Do

- Sponsor the Spiritual Adoption
 Program that educates parishioners
 about the monthly development of
 infants from conception to birth. The
 parish is asked to pray for the well
 being of all pregnant women during
 the program.
- Provide space on the Respect Life kiosk for pregnant mothers in the parish to keep the parish updated on their pregnancies and births.
- Sponsor a baby shower in the spring for the mothers at Harrington House.
 Parishioners are encouraged to provide baby items to these women.
- Co-sponsor a poster contest with the Knights of Columbus for elementary and junior high school students that centers on "Life" themes.
- Provide resources for women, who may be experiencing an unplanned pregnancy, to organizations that will assist them. Provide information on "Project Rachel" that assists women suffering from the after-effects of an abortion.
- Provide compassion, prayer and companionship to the elderly and seriously ill.
- Promote opportunities for care for the vulnerable – from the preborn to the elderly – in our parish and the community at large.
- Alert the parish to legislation on the local and national level that affect Life issues, and encourage parishioners to contact their elected officials. Coordinate attendance at the March for Life in Olympia in January.

Prepares/Gabriel Project/

PREPARES, sponsored by the Catholic Bishops of Washington State and open to all people. PREPARES provides services to pregnant mothers, fathers, and their families by walking with them on the journey from pregnancy to the child's fifth birthday. PREPARES provides pregnancy and parenting support and activities through Catholic parishes across the state. One does not need to be Catholic to receive anything through PREPARES.



PREPARES supports the commitment to the sanctity of human life, especially in its most vulnerable early stages. It seeks not only to assure healthy births and avoid the tragedy of abortion, but also to provide emotional support to nurture the family as the essential unit of society. Pregnant women can request assistance by calling 1-888-926-2643. The woman is assigned to the Prepares/ Gabriel Project parish nearest to where she lives.
