MINISTRY EXPECTATIONS

How do I become a member of the Social Life Committee? An interest in the committee can be indicated on the Stewardship of Talent card; or you may contact the parish office or the ministry leader, directly.

What defines an "active" member of Social Life? Core Team members help plan each event and are expected to attend the planning meeting associated with each event. Event Team members are invited to attend committee meetings but mostly are involved in helping before, during and or after the actual event.

How do I end my membership in committee? Notify the committee leader or the parish office that you are no longer interested in being a member.

Is the attire of the member important?
Each event has a different "look and feel" and the member should dress appropriately. Spring Fling-business casual, Summerfest-totally casual, Marian Festival Dinner-dressy casual.

What special talents/characteristics are desired in a member of the committee? Members should have a keen spirit of team, service and hospitality; all talents and skills are welcome.

What is the time commitment? There are 2-9 meetings per year, not everyone is expected to attend all meetings. Actual event times varies; not everyone assists at all events. Time commitment is flexible.

What can I expect in the way of support/ training for my role in the committee? You volunteer for the role you feel most comfortable filling; for every role there is a team captain who will provide quidance.
