MINISTRY EXPECTATIONS

How do I become a member of the Sound/AV Ministry? Indicate an interest in the ministry on the Stewardship of Talent card; or you may contact the parish office or the ministry leader, directly.

What defines an "active" member? A person who is knowledgeable in the use of and supports the parish with the operation of the sound and/or video components of Mass or other events held in the sanctuary, social hall or anywhere on the parish grounds.

How do I end my ministry? Notify the parish office or the ministry co-ordinator.

Is the attire of the member important? No.

What special talents/characteristics are desired in a crew member? A desire to learn the techniques required to operate the audio and video components in the various environments at MQP.

*What is the time commitment?*1-3 hours depending on the duration of the particular event.

What can I expect in the way of support/training for my role as crew member? Training is offered before and during Masses and/or other events.
